

## Exploring Growth

If you haven't already shown your students the BBC's 'What is GDP?' clip, it's probably worth doing so:

Then, assuming you have access to internet enabled devices, get your students to look at the links between GDP/capita and other variables to come to a conclusion about the extent to which growth is good.

A list of variables that might be useful:

- Life expectancy
- Improved sanitation
- CO<sub>2</sub> emissions per person (log not linear)
- Literacy rates
- Murder rates
- Child mortality rates
- Employment by sector (agriculture)

Growth and other objectives

One good exercise is the one on Australia from the AD/AS section, which can be done at this stage (AD/AS diagrams aren't needed, although some understanding of actual and potential growth is useful). You will find this in the Australia vs UK resource in Unit 5
