



Council of Trent	Summary of key points
On Baptism	Baptism is necessary for remission of sins and salvation. It removes original sin.
On keeping the commandments and Canon 20	Being justified does not free a person from keeping the commandments. Justification can be lost through disobedience.
On justification Canon 1	Justification requires divine grace.
On justification Canon 9	Justification does not take place by faith alone.
On justification Canon 17	No one can know who has received the grace of God (a rejection of the confidence of the Protestants).
Importance of works Canon 24	Justification is preserved through good works rather than good works just being the signs of justification.
