

La casa de Bernarda Alba - Federico García Lorca

Finished just before the playwright's death in 1936, La Casa de Bernarda explores female experiences in early 20th century Andalusia. Conditioned by religion, social pressures and a fear of gossip, the eponymous protagonist goes to great lengths to maintain control over her life and daughters. As the play progresses and the stifling summer heat rises, Bernarda's tyranny heightens and the girls feel increasingly oppressed. Adela, in particular, longs for freedom and embarks on an affair with Pepe el Romano who is betrothed to her older sister, Angustias. However, despite being warned on several occasions by La Poncia, her lifelong servant, Bernarda refuses to give in, ultimately leading to her youngest daughter's tragic suicide.
